
















#### **Observation:**

#### 2. Employability is given weightage in curriculum design and development






#### **Observation:**





#### 6. Representation from colleges in Academic Council is helpful in designing and improving the courses










#### # Opinion regarding present status of college than earlier


#### # Opinion on present academic environment


#### # Opinion on academic performance of the students


#### # Co-curricular activities of the college adequate


#How do you rate the difference in the physical & academic infrastructures between past & present?


#### #How do you rate the library facilities of the Institution?


#### #Do you feel the College environment is safe & secure for your ward?

# **IQAC RECOMMENDATIONS:**

IQAC submitted the feedback analysis report to the management. Following are some of the recommendations made:

- To encourage students' orientation towards research-based activities, it is recommended that educators offer them with a hands-on experience outside of the classroom.
- To increase students' competency in their careers, soft skill training is necessary.
- Curriculum revisions are necessary from time to time for course content.
- When designing and developing a syllabus, educators need to be fairly represented.
- As per the suggestions, more skill based courses should be incorporated into the curriculum.
- There should be more remedial instruction included in the regular schedule.
