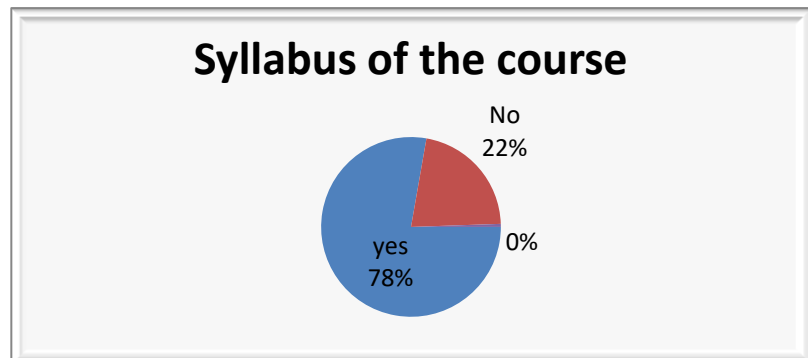

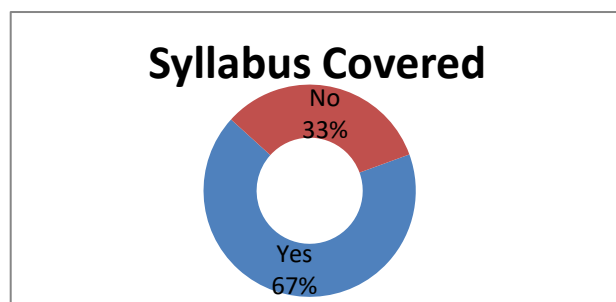

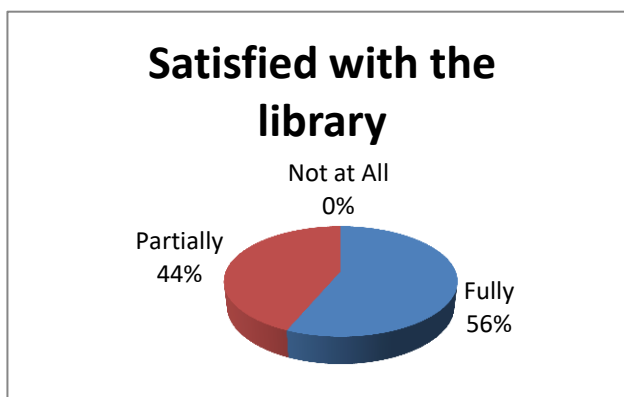

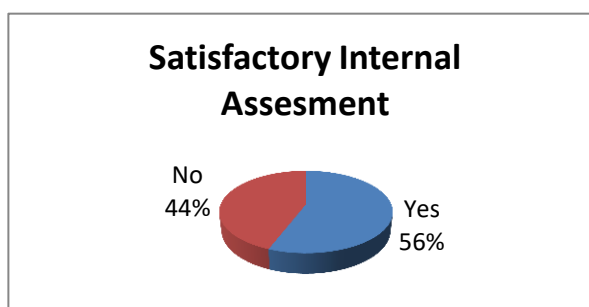

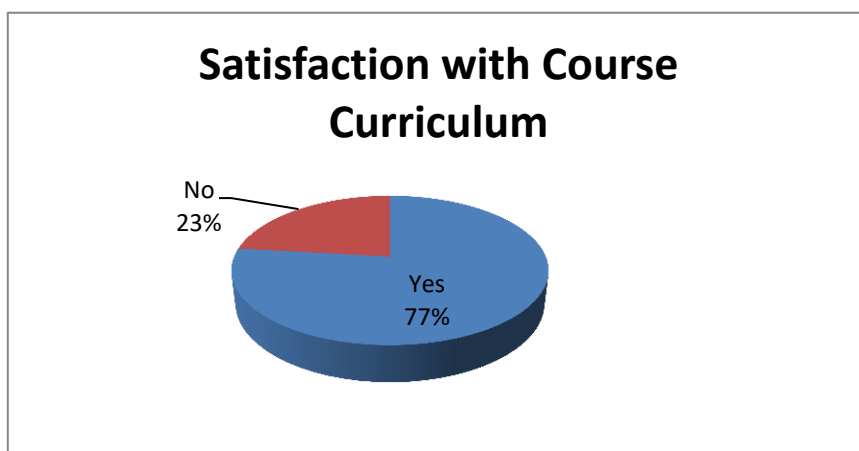

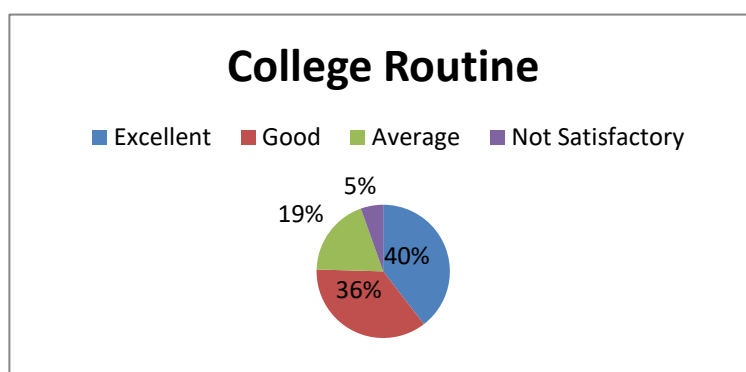

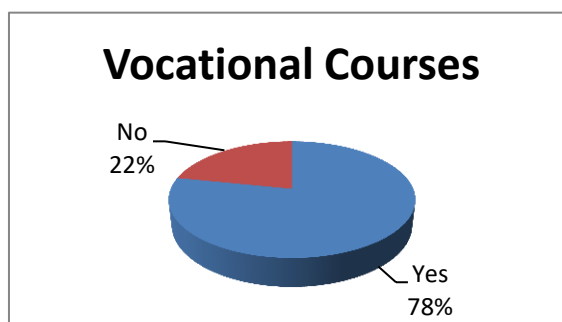

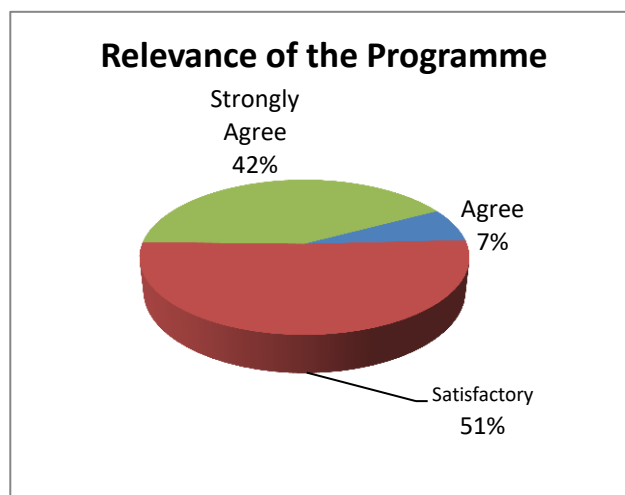

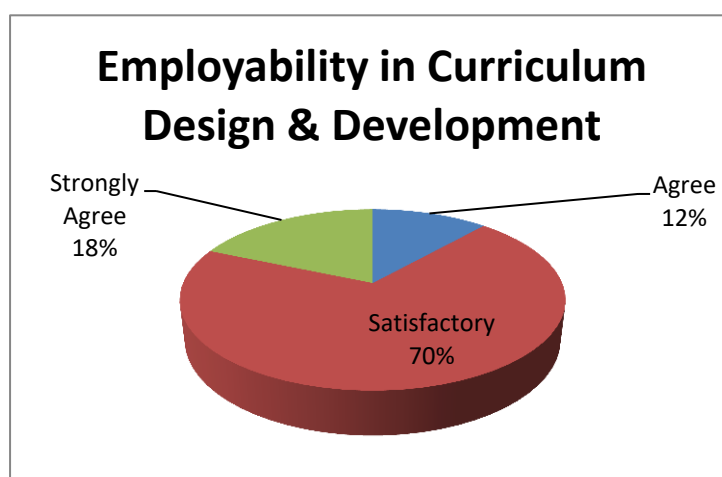


Observation:

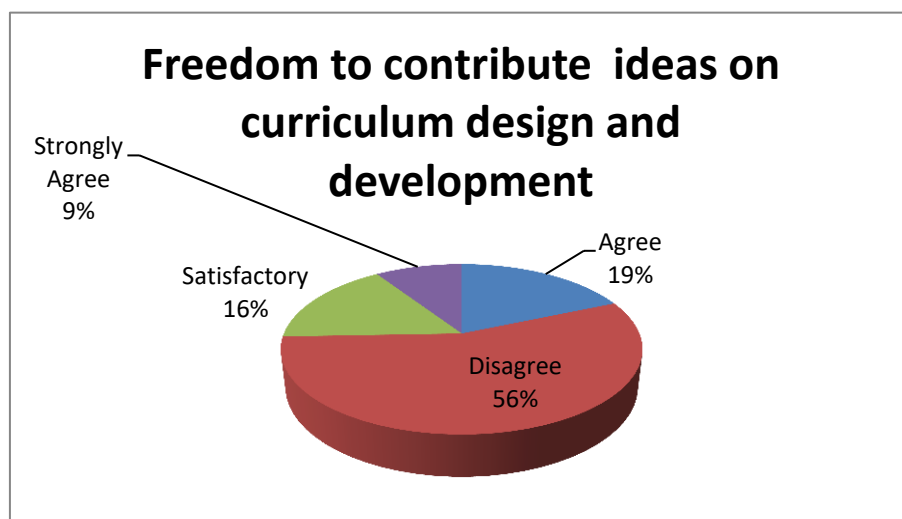


Observation:

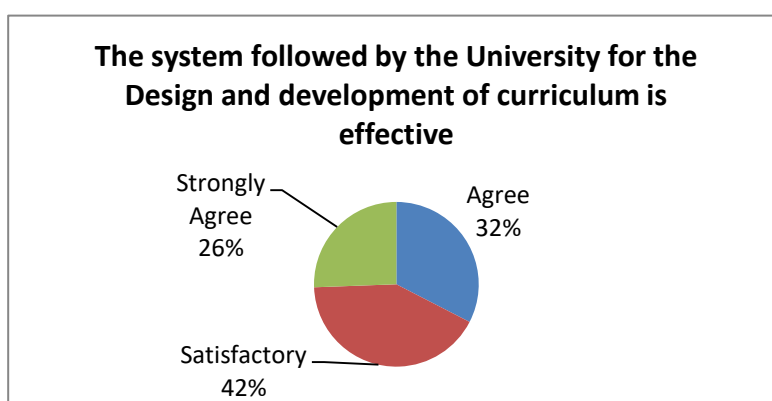

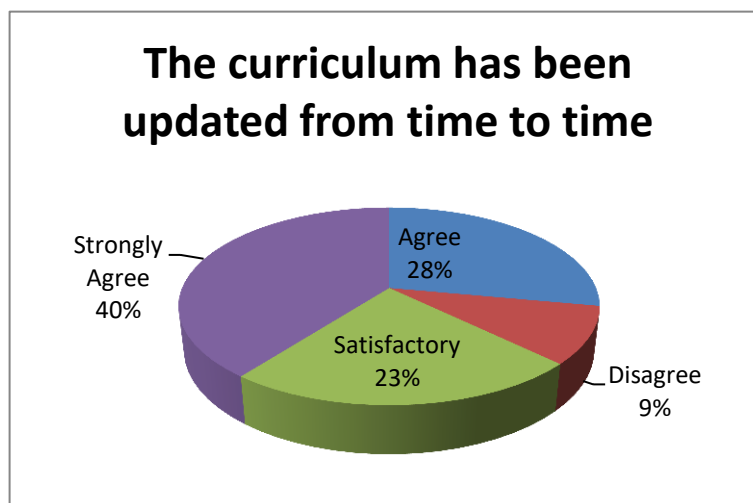


Observation:

5. The curriculum has been updated from time to time

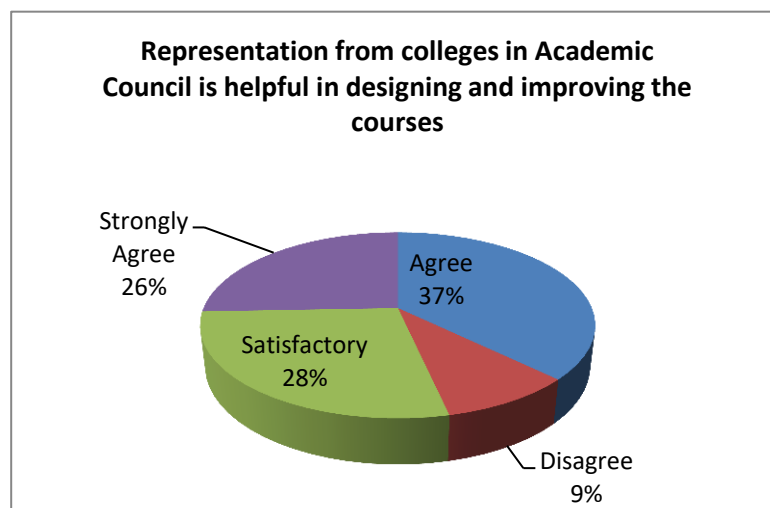

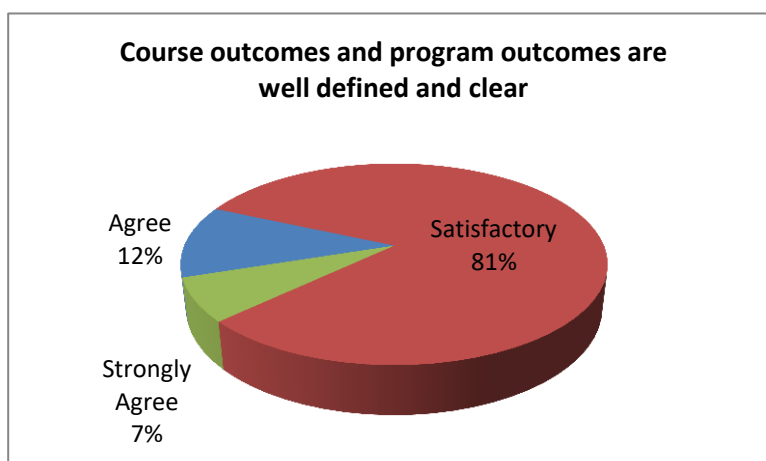


Observation:

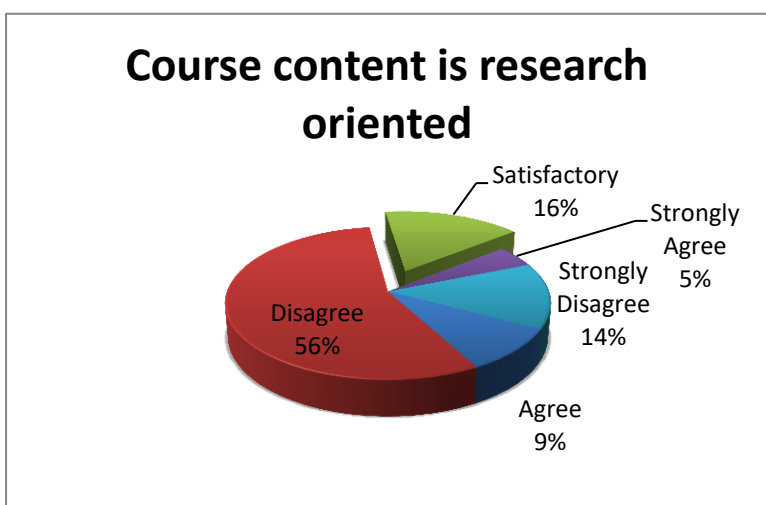

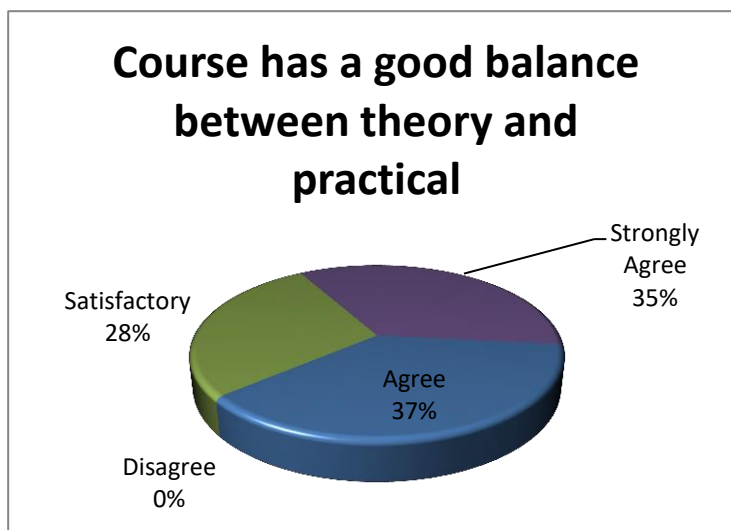


Observation:

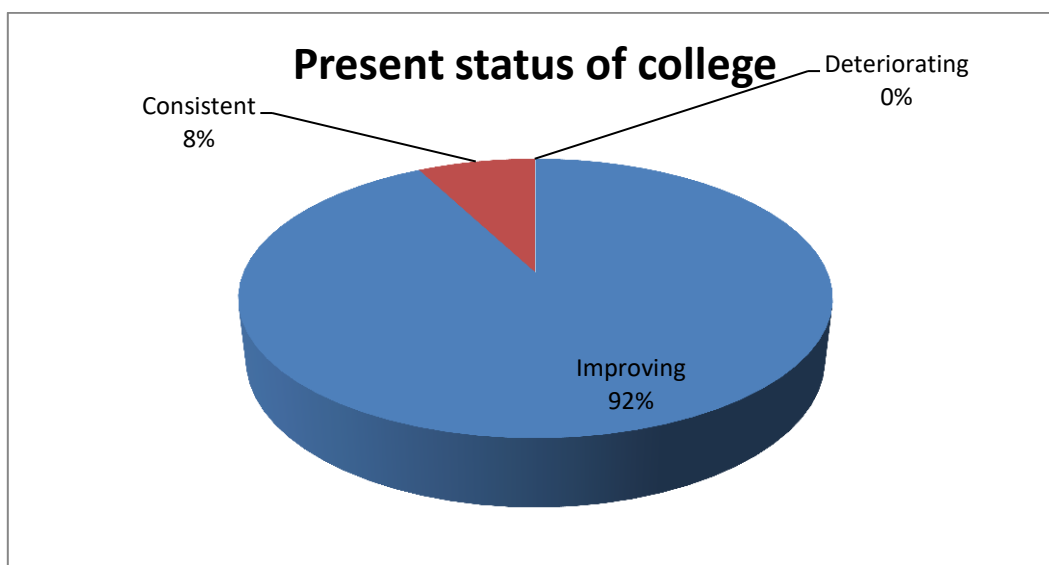

Total Alumni feedback received in the year is 52. Some of the vital aspects of the feedback are represented here.

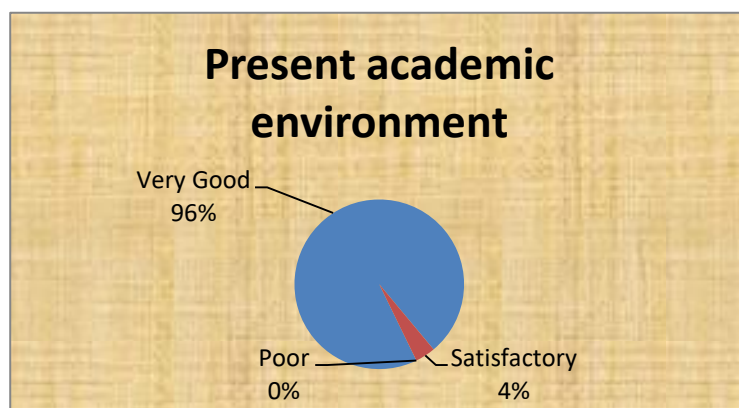
Opinion regarding present status of college than earlier

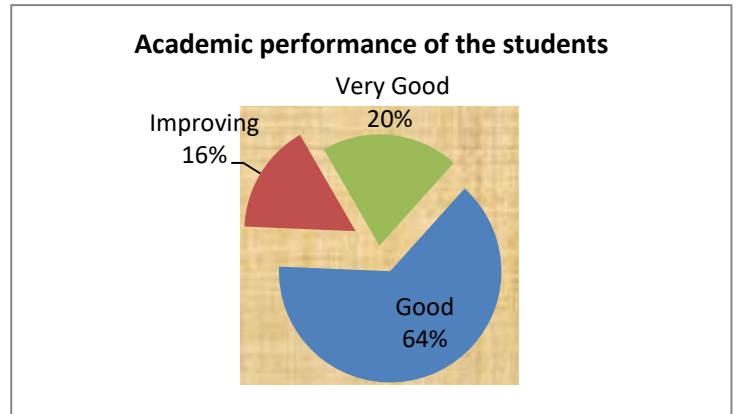
Opinion on present academic environment

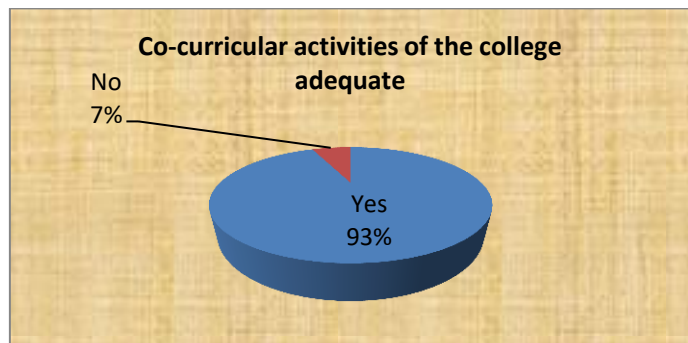
Opinion on academic performance of the students

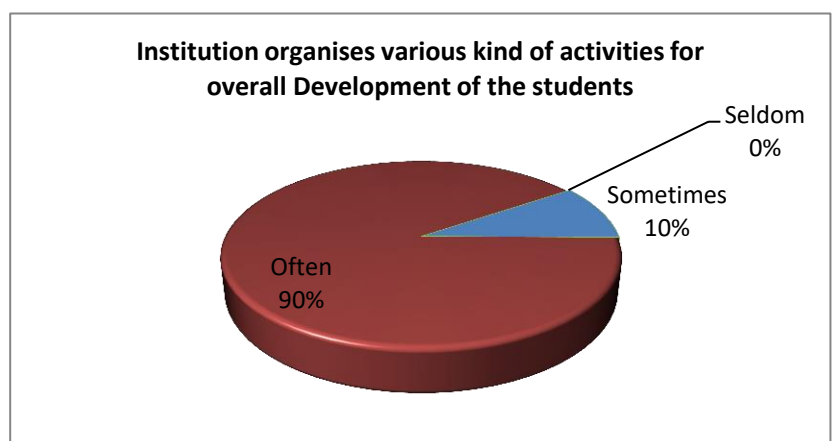
Co-curricular activities of the college adequate

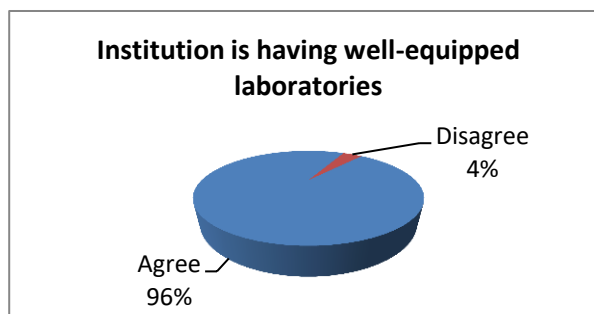

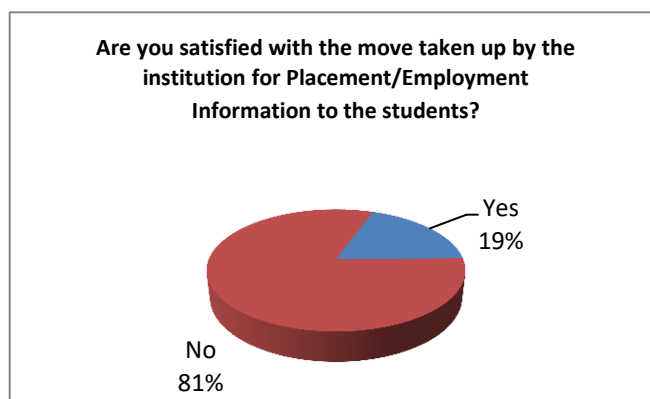

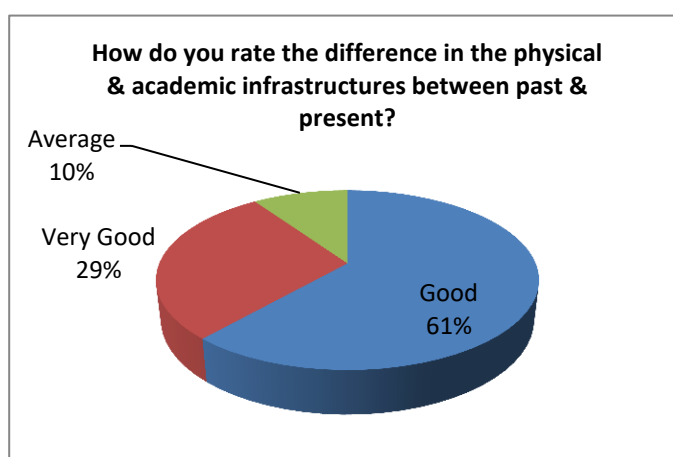
Are you satisfied with the move taken up by the institution for Placement/Employment information to the students?

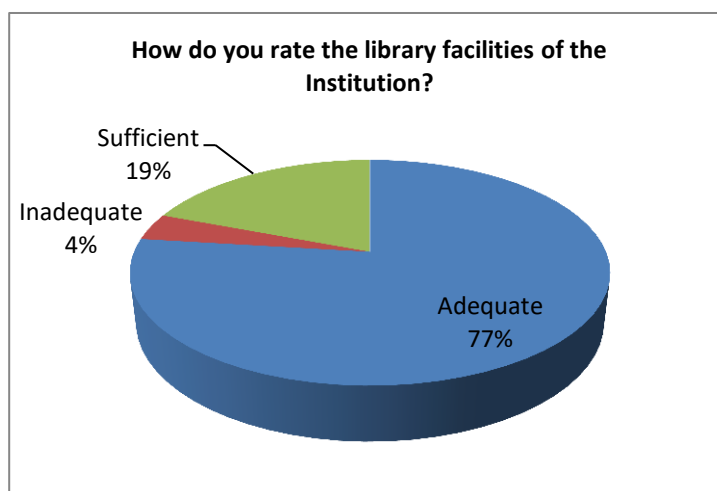
#How do you rate the difference in the physical & academic infrastructures between past & present?

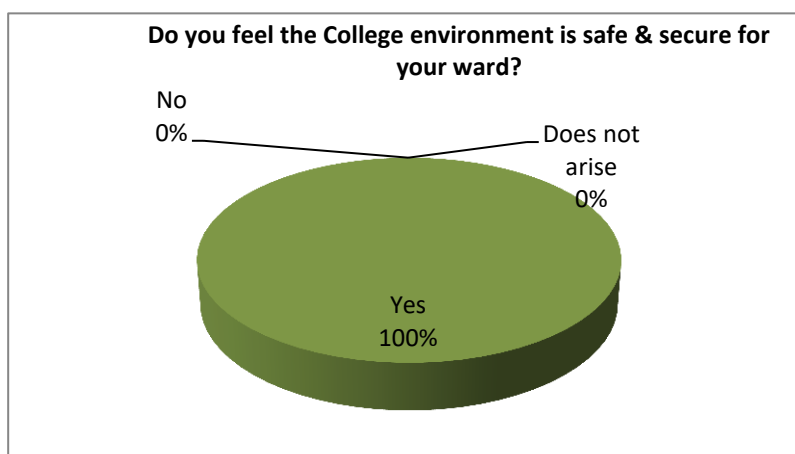
#How do you rate the library facilities of the Institution?

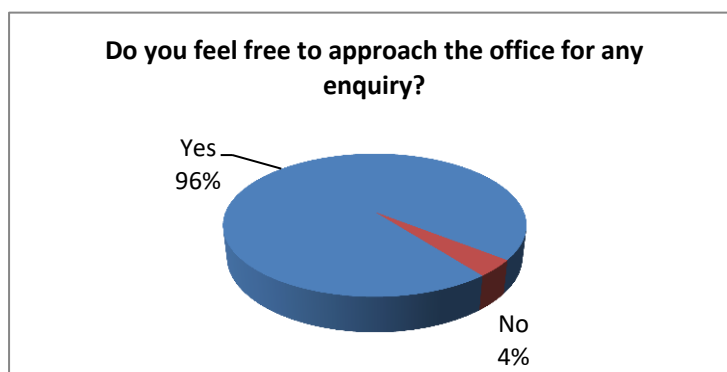
#Do you feel the College environment is safe & secure for your ward?

IQAC RECOMMENDATIONS:

IQAC submitted the feedback analysis report to the management. Following are some of the recommendations made:

- As per the suggestions, a practical approach beyond classroom teaching should be provided to students in order to foster their orientation towards research based activities.
- There is a need to impart Soft skills training to students so as to enhance their competence in their careers
- Course content in the curriculum has to be revised from time to time
- There must be a good representation of teachers in the design and development of syllabus.
- As per the suggestions, more skill based courses should be incorporated into the curriculum.
- More remedial classes should be incorporated in the daily routine.
