# Programme Specific outcome (B.A History)

Specific outcome of studying the syllabus prescribed for the students of History major/general classes may be cited below:

• On the completion of this course the students will be able to explain & reconstruct the linkages of the History of India under the Mughal Rule.

Paper: HIS-HC-5016 Rise of the Modern Europe- I (c.1780-1939)

• After completion of this course the students will be able to evaluate the historical evolution and political developments that occurred in Europe in the period between 1780 to 1939.

• The will also be able to relate to the variety of causes that dragged the world into devastating wars in the intervening period.

Paper: HIS-HC-5026 History of India VII (c.1780-1857)

• On the completion of this course the students will be able to relate to the circumstances leading to the consolidation of colonial rule over India and their consequences.

• The course will also enable the students to analyze popular uprisings among the tribal, peasants and common people against the British policies.

Paper: HIS-HE-5016 History of Assam (Upto c. 1228)

• After completion of this course the students will be acquainted with major stages of developments in the political, social and cultural history of Assam from the earliest times to the advent of the Ahoms in the 13<sup>th</sup> century CE.

Paper: HIS-HE-5026 History of Assam (c. 1228-1826)

- Upon completion of this course the students will be able to identify major stages of developments in the political, social and cultural history of Assam during the medieval times.
- This paper will enable the students to understand the scenario of Assam before the arrival of the British and the occupation of the region by the English East India Company.

Paper: HIS-HC-6016 History of India VIII (c.1857-1950)

- At the completion of this course the students will be able to analyze the course of British colonial exploitation, the social mobilizations during the period between c.1857 to 1950.
- They will also be able to explain the circumstances leading to de-colonization and also the initial period of nation building in India.

Paper: HIS-HC-6016 Rise of the Modern Europe- II (c.1780-1939)

- After the completion of this course the students will be able to analyze the historical developments in Europe between c.1780 to 1939.
- The course will also enable the students to situate the historical development of working class movements, socialist upsurge and the economic forces of the two world wars and the other ideological shifts of Europe in the period under study.

Paper: HIS-HE-6016 History of Assam (c.1826-1947)

- Upon completion of this course the students will be able to describe the period of British rule in Assam after its annexation by the imperialist forces.
- The course would enable the students to analyze the main currents of the political and socio-economic developments in Assam during the colonial period.

Paper: HIS-HE-6026 Assam Since Independence

- After the completion of this course the students will be able to assess the aftermath of partition & other socio-economic developments in post-independence Assam.
- The students will also understand the causes and impact of various struggles and movements in contemporary Assam after India's independence.

Paper: 101 Introduction to History

- After the completion of this course the students will be able to understand the meaning & scope of history.
- The students will also be able to understand the relation of history with other disciplines of humanities like archaeology, sociology, political science etc.
- On the completion of this course the student will also be introduced to the idea of historiography.

Paper: 102 History of India (Upto A.D.300)

- After the completion of this course the students will be able to understand about the different kinds of sources of history and the pre-historic phases of Indian history.
- They will also be able to understand the Mauryan empire and its structure.
- They will also be able to assess the impact of post Mauryan invasions on Indian society & culture.

Paper: 203 History Of India (300 AD -1200 AD)

• After the completion of this course, students will be able to explain the economic & socio-cultural connections, transitions and stratifications during the periods from 300 CE to 1200 CE.

Paper: 204 History OF Ancient Civilizations Of The World

• After completion of this course the students will be able to explain the processes and stages of the evolution of the variety of cultural pattern throughout antiquarian periods in history.

• They will also be able to relate the connections between the various bronze age civilizations in the ancient world.

Paper: 305 India Under The Turko-Afghans

- On the completion of this course the students will be able to understand the political & administrative history of India from the beginning of Turkish invasions, the formation of Delhi Sultanate till its decline.
- They will also be able to analyze the sources of history, regional variations, social, cultural and economic set up of the period.

Paper: 306 History of Assam (5th Century C.E. to 1228)

- After completion of this course the students will be acquainted with major stages of developments in the political, social and cultural history of Assam from the 5<sup>th</sup> century CE to 1228 CE.
- This course will also enable the students about major stages of developments in political, social and cultural history of Assam during the early times.

Paper: 407 India Under The Mughals

- After completion of this course the students will be able to analyze the circumstances and historical shifts and foundations of a variety of administrative & political setup in India in the period under study.
- On the completion of this course the students will be able to explain & reconstruct the linkages of the History of India under the Mughal Rule and also the political & social condition for the development of later state structure.

Paper 408 History of Europe (1453-1789)

- After completion of this course the students will be able to define the major trends and developments in the Western World between 1453 to 1789 CE.
- They will also be able to explore and analyze the significant historical shifts and events and the resultant effects on the civilizations of Europe in the period.

## Paper 509: India Under the East India Company

- On the completion of this course the students will be able to relate to the circumstances leading to the consolidation of colonial rule over India and their consequences.
- The course will also enable the students to analyze popular uprisings among the tribal, peasants and common people against the British policies.

#### Paper: 510 history of Assam (1228-1826)

- Upon completion of this course the students will be able to identify major stages of developments in the political, social and cultural history of Assam during the medieval times.

## Paper: 511 History of Europe (1789-1870)

- Upon completion of this course the students will be able to assess the technological developments in early as well as medieval period of Indian history.
- This course will also enable the students to explain the early development of Science among Indian intelligentsia.

## Paper 513 History of Great Britain (1485-1820)

- After completion of this course the students will be able to explain the political condition of England under the ruling houses of Tudors and Stuarts.
- They will also be able to analyze the constitutional developments in England between 1485-1820 CE.

#### Paper 514 History of China (1839 - 1949)

• On the completion of this course the students will be able to understand the condition of China before and after the advent of Imperialist powers.

• They will also be able to explain the growth of nationalism and communalism in China in the 20<sup>th</sup> century.

Paper: 615 India under the Crown

• At the completion of this course the students will be able to analyze the course of exploitation and the social mobilizations under the British Rule.

• They will also be able to explain the circumstances leading to de-colonization and also the initial period of nation building in India.

Paper: 616 History of Assam (1826-1947)

• Upon completion of this course the students will be able to describe the period of British rule in Assam after its annexation by the imperialist forces.

Paper: 617 History of Europe (1871-1945)

Paper: 618 World Since 1945s

Paper: 619 History of Japan (1853-1941)
