The following mentioned actions have been implemented to address the recommendations provided by the IQAC on the basis of students' feedback. These steps are aimed at enhancing the overall educational experience, equipping students with necessary skills, and ensuring that the curriculum remains effective. Continuous efforts will be made to evaluate and improve these initiatives for sustained student success.

Implementation of Recommendations for-

- Regular Provision of Scholarship Information: It was suggested that information about available scholarships be provided regularly to students. A dedicated bulletin board was set up to display updated scholarship information. Information is updated regularly, and announcements are made in notice boards.
- 2. Conducting Summer Camp: It was suggested to conduct a summer camp to provide students with additional learning and recreational opportunities during the summer break. A summer camp on Khol Vadya Training Camp was planned and organised during summer vacation where 45 students participated. The camp received positive feedback, with participants appreciating the combination of educational and recreational activities.
- 3. Educational Tour: It was suggested to organise educational tours to provide students with practical exposure to their field of study. Accordingly various departments organised educational tour and students participated in the tour, accompanied by faculty members. The tour included visits to key sites, lectures, and hands-on experiences, which greatly enhanced the students' understanding of their subject matter.
- 4. Renovation of Canteen Facility: It was recommended that the canteen facility be renovated to enhance the infrastructure and ensure better hygiene, seating arrangements and overall betterment. Improvements include modernizing the kitchen area, enhancing ventilation, upgrading the seating area with new furniture, and installing better lighting.
- 5. Generator Facility: It was recommended that a generator facility be installed to ensure an uninterrupted power supply during outages. Based on the analysis, a generator with the required capacity was procured and installed in the college premises. The generator is now fully operational and has been used during power outages.

6.Improvement of Sports Facilities: It was recommended to improve the sports facilities to enhance the physical fitness and recreational opportunities for employees/students and promote a healthy lifestyle. New sports equipment were purchased and made available for students



7. ICT Enabled Classroom development: It was recommended to develop ICT (Information and Communication Technology) enabled classrooms to enhance the teaching and learning experience through the integration of digital tools and resources. In order to do so, various equipment like Digital Boards, Projectors, Sound system, etc. procured and installed at a few designated classrooms to convert them into digital classroom

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The feedback obtained is being analyzed and utilized for overall development of the institution. As the session 2019-2020 coincided with the outbreak of CORONA, so feedback was processed partially taking into consideration with limited number and accordingly analysed.

Implementation of Recommendations for-

- 1. Promotion of Skill-Based Learning for Students: It was suggested to promote skill-based learning among students to enhance their practical abilities and employability. For that purpose, Skill-based courses and workshops were integrated into the CBCS curriculum. Collaborations with industry experts and vocational training institutes were executed to provide hands-on learning opportunities. Regular workshops, seminars, and guest lectures on relevant skills were conducted. Certification programs were introduced for specific skills, and students were encouraged to participate.
- 2. Improvement of Drinking Water Facility: It was suggested to improve the drinking water facilities on campus to ensure clean and safe water is available for all. New water purifiers were installed at key locations on campus.
- 3. Provision of photocopying Facility: It was suggested to provide a photocopying facility on campus for the convenience of students and staff. A photocopying facility was set up in the library which was made available for all the stakeholders of the college. The service is offered at affordable rates to ensure accessibility for all students.
- 4. Campus Interview: It was suggested to organise campus interviews to improve employment opportunities for students. Outreach to various companies and organizations began to invite them for campus recruitment drives. Campus interviews were initiated with participation from them for campus recruitment drives. 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
