The college canteen has witnessed a great improvement in the areas of convenience and hygiene recently.

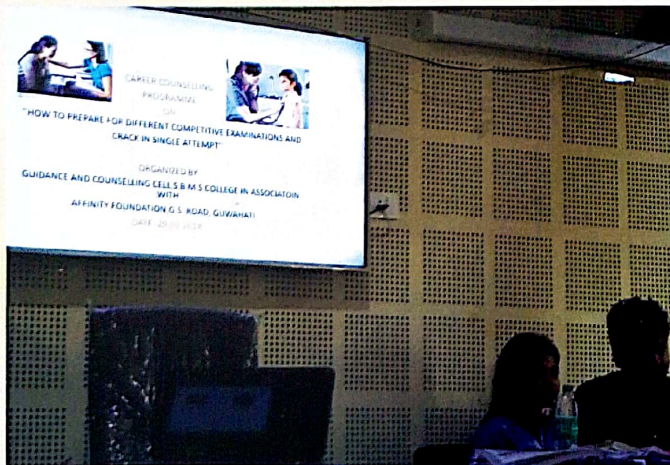


Plantation

A Career Counseling programme on 29/9/18 and a Freshers induction programme on 2/8/2018 was held for the benefit of the students.

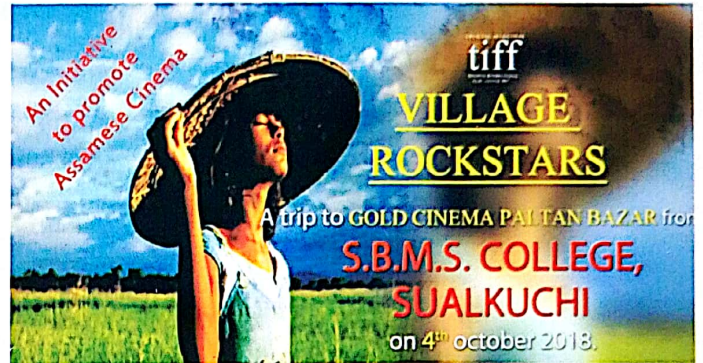


(iii) A new incinerator for toilet-pads has been installed in the ladies toilet.

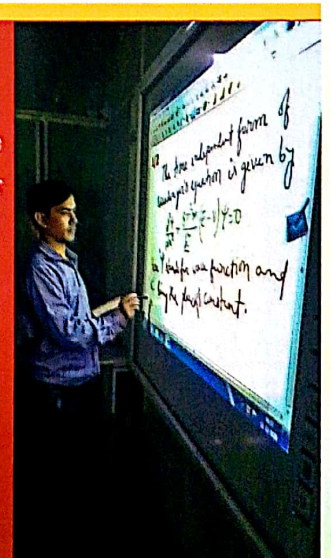


New Installations
