

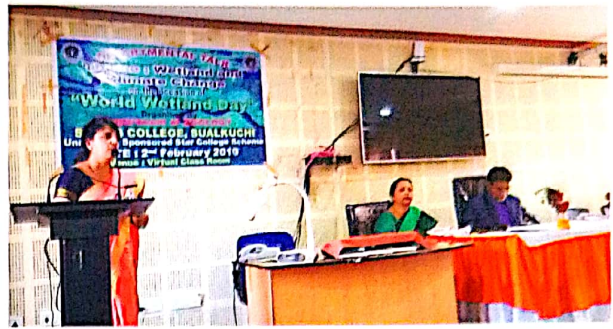

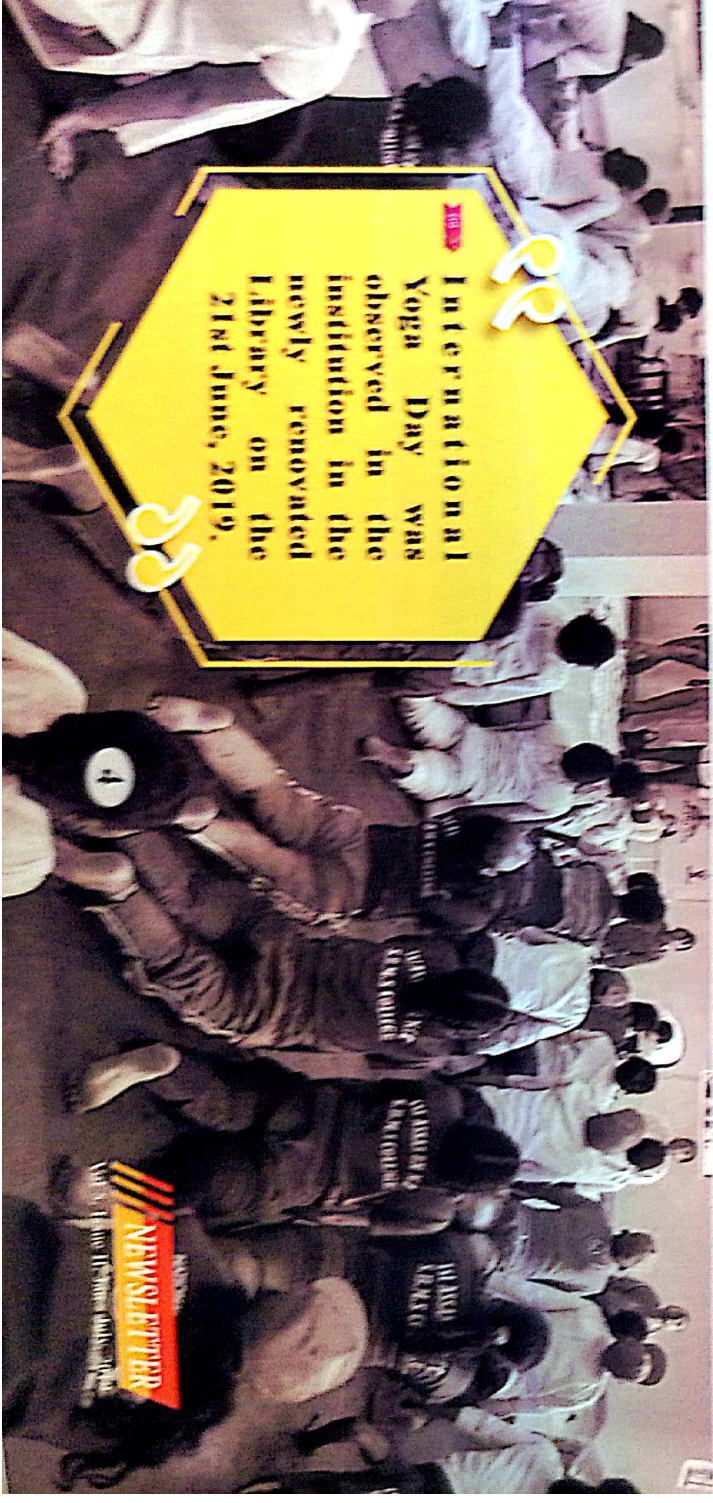
Organized by the Department of Zoology in association with Assam Zoological Society, a plantation programme was held on the 12th June, 2019, in the college campus.

The Department of Botany organized a Workshop "Plant Collection, Preservation and Herbarium Preparation Techniques" which was held on 6th March, 2019.



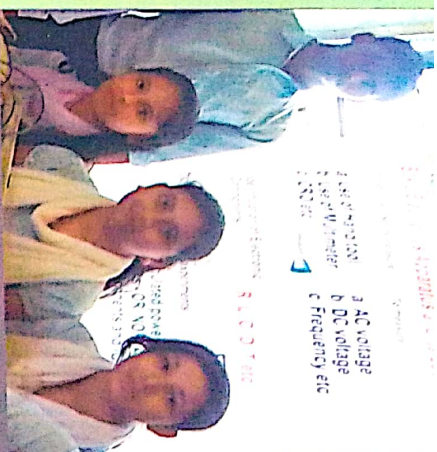
A Workshop on "Foldscope" was organized by the Department of Zoology on 3rd April, 2019.
